If you occasionally have recyclables that won't fit inside the bin, put extra items in a brown paper bag, and place next to bin. If we leave items in your recycling bin, the materials may not have been processed properly or they may be unacceptable materials.

New Kensington Public Works Department Policies & Schedules

"WORKING TOGETHER, WITH YOU"

GARBAGE- is picked up throughout the city on Fridays by Waste Management. Pickup will be on Saturday following **Memorial Day, July 4th, Labor Day, and Thanksgiving Day.** If you have any large items to be picked up, please call Waste Management at 1-800-458-4090 to make arrangements. They will not take any building materials (bricks, stones, shingles, etc) or paint. The city does not pick up any items. If you have any questions or problems with your garbage pickup, please call City Hall at 724-337-4523.

RECYCLING- glass bottles, jars, aluminum, and bimetal cans are to be placed inside the yellow recycling bin and <u>set out at the curbside the night before your pickup day</u>. Bins having garbage or food residue in them will not be picked up. The City Garage building has three green bins for recyclable plastics, flattened cardboard, newspapers, magazines, catalogs and other paper products which may be dropped off at the city garage at your convenience.

DUMPSTERS- located on City property are for City use **only**. These dumpsters are not available for residents or contractors. There is a "NO DUMPING / \$500 FINE" POSTED ON THE PREMISES that is enforced.

SPRING CLEANUP- the City conducts a spring cleanup once a year at the City Garage Monday, May 7th to Saturday, May 12th between the hours of 7 am and 3 pm. This is the only time that the City has dumpsters available for residents to use. Please have proper ID ready for proof of residency. For more information, call 724.335.5421.

BRANCHES- the Street Department will pick up branches during the months of **May thru September ONLY**. After October 1st branches may be dropped off at the City Garage by appointment only. Branches must be between 2 and 8 feet long and no more than 8 inches in diameter, stacked neatly with the cut ends facing the street. Call 724.335.5421 and we will put you on the branch pick up list. The chipper does not operate every day, please be patient for your pickup. Small clippings may be put into garbage bags and set out for regular garbage pickup on Fridays.

LEAVES- will be picked up through the month of October and into December as weather permits. Please rake leaves to the curb without creating a safety hazard. We have a schedule we follow that rotates throughout the City, which does not permit us to pick up leaves by special request. Please do not rake leaves out to the curb after the truck goes by and then call us to pick up your leaves. You may bag your leaves and put them out for regular garbage pickup on Fridays.

Please understand, we, as much as you, want these pickups done to help you make our City a little nicer and to get on with our other duties. We do not ignore or purposely leave piles of branches or leaves lying around. However there will be times when emergencies and circumstances arise that may cause a small delay in our pickups.

We appreciate your understanding.

SNOW REMOVAL- we realize that everyone needs their street cleared as soon as possible. However, it is impossible to do all the streets at one time. Therefore, we follow these guidelines – main arteries, bridges, bypasses, then hills, side streets and alleys.

POTHOLES- we periodically go through the City filling potholes. You are welcome to call our attention to the potholes we might have missed or have not yet completed.

MEMORIAL PARK- reservations for Memorial Park pavilions are taken after the first of the year for bookings between Memorial Day and Labor Day. Please contact the Park's office from 8 am to 3:30 pm, Monday thru Friday, at 724.335.8005 for pricing, information and availability.

MASSA HARBISON- reservations for Massa Harbison are taken by the City Clerk's office from 9 am to 5 pm, Monday thru Friday, at 724.337.4523. The price for rental is \$125.00 with a \$50.00 deposit required at time of booking.
